## **Guideline for Poster/Demo Session**

- For the participation of Poster/Demo Session, it is necessary to register for the full-pass of ISEA2019.
- You should prepare your poster well in advance of the symposium and bring your printed poster materials to the symposium.
- Poster presenters are responsible for mounting and removing their posters themselves.
- Poster boards in the poster area will be numbered and ordered using the abstract number. You will also find your abstract number in the Poster session program on the ISEA2019 website.
- A supply of tape will be available in the poster area for mounting your materials.
- All posters should be mounted no later than 10:00 a.m. June 24(Mon) and can be taken down after 5:00 p.m. June 27(Thur), but no later than 6:00 p.m.
- After the allocated poster session, authors must remove their posters by the nominated removal time. Failure to do so will result in their removal by the ISEA2019 Organizing Committee who will not be responsible for posters not removed by the due time.

## **Poster Format**

- It is recommended to place the poster title, author(s)'s name(s) and affiliation(s) on your poster.
- Poster material must be prepared in advance and should be large enough to be viewed from a distance of one meter.
- Recommended poster format is A0 size, 85 cm (~ 34 IN) in width and 120 cm (~ 48 IN) in height.
